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## COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

ANNOUNCEMENT: The Summer Program committee announces that during the week of May 5 to 9 payment of the Bs 50 per family required of those who wish to participate in the program will be received on three different days. Those wishing to pay may do so between 4 and 5:30 p.m. in the Adaro Club Lounge or in the Garage of the Community Center in Judibana on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, May 5, 7 and 9. No house-to-house collections will be made.

At the regular Council meeting held Monday afternoon in the Civic Center the report of the nominating committee was read. Ballots were sent out this week for the primary election, and they must be deposited in one of the election boxes by May 3 if they are to be counted. Voters have the privilege of write-in votes in the primary ONLY. There will be only two names for each office in the run-off or final election.

SPECIAL NOTICE: Anyone whose name appears on the primary ballot and who does not wish to serve in that capacity if elected is instructed to notify the Council President John Van Curen no later than May 3. Failure to do so will signify one's willingness to serve.

A report was read concerning the recent meeting Council officers had with Mr. Hugh Wynne at which the new Housing Project in Judibana was discussed. The complete report of that meeting follows:

Meeting of Community Council with Mr. Hugh Wynne to discuss the new Housing Project in Judibana

Mr. Wynne stated that he had asked the Council to meet with him in order to familiarize them with the new staff housing project nearing completion and possibly get some ideas from them on some of the problems that will be encountered in moving people into the new houses.

A plan of the area was distributed to those present for purposes of orientation and to facilitate discussions. Mr. Wynne explained the following points:

1. The new houses are being built to permit abandonment of Adaro by December 31, 1958, as maintenance of the Adaro houses are almost twice as much as that of the Judibana houses. This does not mean that residents in Adaro will all go into the new houses. Assignment will be in accordance with the Company's policy of assigning houses on the point system, taking into account amount of service, salary and salary group.
2. The project originally embodied 121 houses but due to the present austerity program, these have been reduced to 98. However, streets and water lines have been laid for the remaining 25 and are ready for any future building.
3. There are only 2- and 3-bedroom houses among those being constructed. The houses are one of 2 types - A and B. Type A is a modification of the present Judibana houses, and type B is a completely new design.
4. Rents on all Creole houses throughout the Company are determined by a formula. This formula is similar to the one the Government uses to determine maximum rents on houses.
5. Rents on Judibana staff houses are, and will be, as follows:

(Increased rents on Types A and B are due to additional features such as extra bathroom, bath-tub, breakfast nook, etc.)
6. Bachelor Housing - It is intended eventually to house the bachelors in accommodations built especially for them. Present plans are for the Company to supply maintenance of yards and maid service if desired for which they will be charged accordingly. The Council was in agreement with these arrangements.
7. Designation of houses - Of the 98 houses, 4 will be set aside as guest houses, and 5 or 6 will be reserved for school teachers. The rest will be thrown open at the same time and will be available for (other column)

assignment to bachelor and married staff employees on the point system.

8. Moves - Moves from Adaro to Judibana, because they are at company convenience, will be for the Company's account, in accordance with company policy. Moves from old Judibana houses to the new ones as well as air conditioner removal and installation, will be for the employee's account.

Mr. Wynne stated that consideration was being given to tree planting and shrubbery around the new houses.

Referring to the naming of streets in the staff rent housing area, Mr. Wynne turned over to the Council a map with suggested names and stated that the Council might review them and make any suggested changes they felt desirable. If these were acceptable to the Company, then the Company would go ahead and put up the street signs and give each house a street number.

Regarding metered rates for Utilities, Mr. Wynne informed the group that he was working on a procedure whereby utility charges would be based purely on consumption, and the blanket charge of Bs 125 and the charge for air conditioning on a tonnage basis would be eliminated, which he hoped would be ready for Caracas consideration soon. Because this has company-wide implications it will have to be considered by the Production Department.

## AMUAY PLAYERS PRESENT "TUNNEL OF LOVE".

The Amuay Players added another successful production to their ever-expanding repertoire when they presented "The Tunnel of Love", the Peter de Vries-Joseph Fields comedy, on last Friday and Saturday nights in the Creole Amuay Club. Herbert Rainbird was the capable director.

I never have been able to understand what makes a play funny, and I am completely at a loss about this one for I came away from it with mixed feelings. There is no doubt that the players gave excellent performances on both nights, but the first night the play to me did not seem particularly funny. Maybe it was the way I felt, or maybe the players tried too hard the first time, but the first-night audience did not seem to appreciate the situations or was not in the right mood either, for there was comparatively little spontaneous laughter. Saturday night was a different story. Though the players spoke the same lines, went through the same motions and worked no harder than the night before, it was like seeing an entirely different play. The audience, too, was a good theatre audience, never missing a cue nor a gag, and the cast cooperated by keeping everything moving at a fast clip. With the kind of dialogue that sustains "The Tunnel of Love" (the only kind Peter de Vries ever writes), one dare not let it lag for a moment or it can fall with a dismal thud.

I know of a good many people who thoroughly enjoyed the efforts put forth by the cast but who did not enjoy the subject matter of the play which may explain why one night it did not seem funny, and the next night hilarious. The weather played the nasty trick on us, and both audiences were painfully aware of the inadequacies of the Club Lounge.

As for the individual players, Joe Curran as Augie Poole, the faithful husband whose one faux pas provided the plot for the play, was believable, lovable and funny. Edith Head as his wife, Isolde, gave a very good account of herself on both nights. How she might have improved the role of the wife desperately wanting the child she had been unable to have after five years of marriage, I haven't the faintest idea. As Dick and Alice Pepper, the couple constantly expecting another child, Bill Byers and Sheila Cooper were certainly competent and humorous. Bill as the philandering husband underplayed the role enough to keep him from being just another insufferable bore, and Sheila was sufficiently blank and trusting to arouse more amused sympathy than disgust.

The way Frances Glackin portrayed her, Estelle Novick, the investigator from the home where the Pooles were trying to adopt a child, was a chic and sophisticated scientist with a beguiling business-then-pleasure personality. She was lovely enough to make it understand-

able how a loyal husband under certain circumstances might momentarily stray from the straight and narrow.

Rita Curran handled the role of Miss McCracken, the second investigator from the home, with a brisk and charming efficiency.

On both nights the bottle of champagne the Peppers gave the Pooles for their wedding anniversary cooperated by giving its own uninhibited performances to the delight of both audiences. Friday night the bottle sent its cork to the ceiling and its bubbly contents all over the bar while Augie Poole (Joe Curran) tried to stem the tide with his thumb, breaking a glass in the process. Even the bottle improved the second night. During the talk about having babies, Alice Pepper had just remarked, "All Dick has to do is just look at me," and at that instant the cork popped from the bottle with a resounding report. Dick Pepper gave a start that was definitely not in the script. Of such is the essence of comedy.

Always a surprising thing about the plays produced here is that each cast is made up of an almost entirely new group. Bill Byers was the only member of this one I had seen play before. Director Rainbird apparently held tight reins on the members of his cast to get from them the kind of performances they gave Saturday night (especially).

Joe Faherty (the veteran stage man) and Jim Barr built the stage set. Sue Foreman and Laurel Jackson with their scenery provided a very satisfactory studio where all the action took place. I do not know if the country scene one could see from the large window looked like the Connecticut countryside or not (I have never been to Westport), but it did look like the Midwest. Other credits go to Jerry Butler as production manager, June Jones for paintings, posters and programs; Win Bishop for Publicity; Jan Owens and Connie Brown, properties; Jane Fructuoso and Gloria Barr, make-up; Ruth Grey, costumes; and Andy Kenney, prompter.

It is too bad that Amuay's facilities for presenting plays are not better for the players and play goers. On both nights several people who came from Shell left because they were unable to see the action on the stage from their seats in the back. Apparently the speaker system was efficient, I heard no one complain that he could not hear. We hope we see the day when our facilities will be as good as our players.

Though I thoroughly enjoyed the performances of the players and am deeply grateful for the entertainment they gave us, the way the weather acted and the way the dialogue of the play sticks to the subject of sex with such a vengeance, there were times that I felt I needed air. Hazel Dedmon

El señor Wynne declaró que había pedido el Consejo se reuniera con él para ponerlo al tanto del nuevo proyecto referente a las casas próximas a terminar y a cruzar ideas sobre los problemas que surgirán cuando se inicie la mudanza.

Se distribuyó un plano entre los presentes para orientar y facilitar la discusión.

El señor gerente explicó los siguientes puntos:

1° Estas casas se están construyendo para lograr la desocupación de Adaro para fines de este año, pues la conservación de las casas de ese campamento es dos veces más costosa que la de Judibana. Lo cual no significa que los residentes de Adaro ocuparán las

nuevas casas. La adjudicación se hará de acuerdo con el sistema de puntos tomando en cuenta el tiempo de servicio, salario y grupo.

- 2° En un principio el proyecto abarcó 121 casas, pero como consecuencia del programa de austeridad se redujo a 98. Con todo, el terreno ha sido urbanizado y está listo para las restantes.
- 3° Estas son casas de 2 y 3 dormitorios, y las hay en los tipos A y B. El tipo A viene a ser una modificación de las casas que ahora existen en Judibana, y el B responde a un diseño completamente nuevo.
- 4° Los alquileres, iguales para toda la Compañía, han sido determinados mediante una fórmula similar a la que emplea el Gobierno para fijar los cánones máximos.
- 5° Los cánones de arrendamiento de las casas de Judibana son, y seguirán siendo, los siguientes:

- 6° Alojamiento para solteros: Existe la intención de alojar a los solteros en viviendas especiales, pero mientras tanto vivirán en las casas de Judibana. Se ha pensado en que la Compañía cuidará de la conservación del patio y atenderá a los servicios de camereros, y que los solteros paguen lo conveniente.
- 7° Adjudicación de casas: De las 98, 4 se usarán como casas de huéspedes y 5 ó 6 se destinarán a las maestras. Las otras quedarán a disposición de solteros y casados y se entregarán de conformidad con el sistema de puntos.
- 8° Mudanzas: Las mudanzas de Adaro a Judibana serán, de acuerdo con las normas vigentes, por cuenta de la Compañía. Pero las que se registren de una a otra casa de Judibana, así como el retiro e instalación de los aparatos de aire acondicionado será por cuenta de los empleados.

El señor Wynne expresó que se está considerando la plantación de árboles y arbustos alrededor de las nuevas casas.

Respecto a la nomenclatura de las calles, el mismo señor pasó un plano al Consejo que incluye nombres, que esta organización podrá adoptar o cambiar a su arbitrio. Si resultarán aceptables, la Compañía seguirá adelante con el proyecto, pondrá los letreros y dará a cada casa un número.

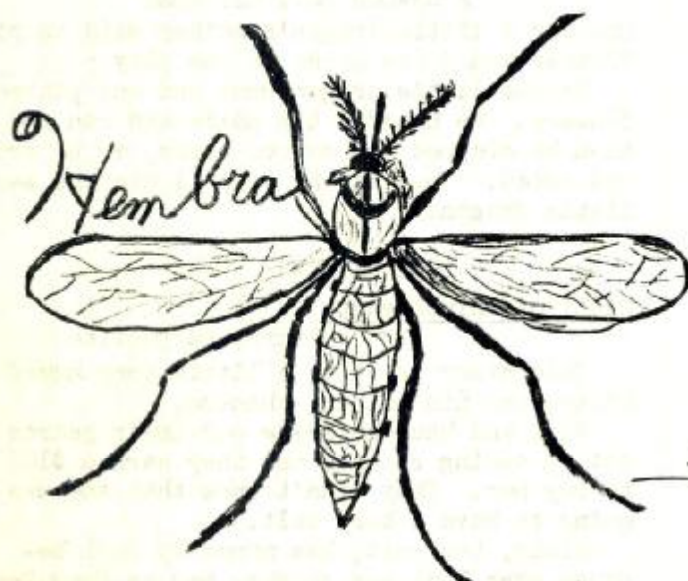

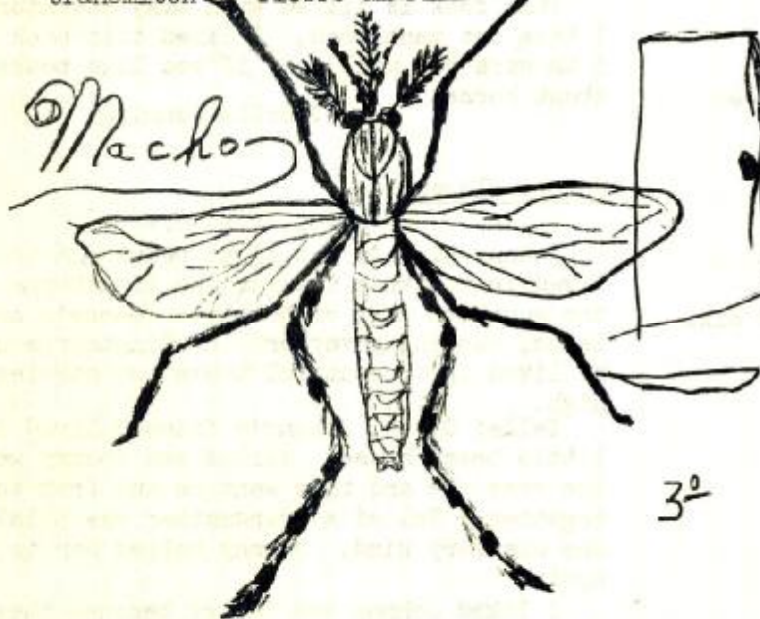
